COMPULSORY PIT STOPS (Round 5 – Saturday X-Country)

Refuelling & Pit Area: A designated refuelling area will be available and all refuelling and mechanical work will be carried out only in this area. There is to be no camping in the pit area during the X-Country event. Compulsory Pit Lane Entry for All Classes: REFUELLING: DRY BRAKE TYPE OF FUELING SYSTEM CAN BE USED

COMPULSORY RIDERS BRIEFING

All riders (parent or guardian if under 18years) must attend, there will be a random roll call, and any competitor not present will be fined.

ALL Riders must read the SAORC Rounds 5 & 6 2024 Riders Briefing Notes on the SAORC Website prior to attending. Riders Briefing is a **NO SMOKING** area

ELECTRONIC SELF SCRUTINEERING & MACHINE EXAMINATION:

ALL JUNIORS & SENIORS

Electronic Self Scrutineering must be completed on the SAORC website and **must be completed by Friday 3pm**. <u>https://www.saoffroadchampionships.com/self-scrutineering/</u>

Machines must comply with the MOMS requirements and the Series Supplementary Regulations. Paddle style tyres are not permitted at this venue.

Random machine examinations will occur throughout the weekend by the Chief Scrutineer and his assistants. Junior and Senior riders will need to present the following items for Random Machine Examination immediately at the request of the Technical Officer.

SIGN ON

Each rider / entrant must present themselves and their licence, either a digital licence via the MA RiderNet app, or hard card licence. It must be legible, show name, licence type and expiry.

BACKUP TIMERS

In the absence of sufficient back up timers for rounds 5 and 6, riders will be required to nominate a backup timer to assist on Sunday for a couple of hours. Time slots will be allocated during rider sign on and a briefing provided to those assisting.

TRACK:

All tracks consist of a mixture of existing Motocross Tracks, flowing natural terrain grass track, tight scrub, rocky trails and some logs. Two arrows adjacent on the course are GATE course markers ie riders MUST ALWAYS pass between these arrows. We will be maintaining the course markings throughout the event, regardless of this, any deviation from the intended course is a breach of these instructions. Riders MUST stay on the "intent" of the course. No Deviation will be accepted.

TIMING TAGS & RACE RESULTS:

Test times will be recorded by Race results.

All riders will be given 2 x Race timing tags, you will need to collect new tags at sign on for the 2024 season. Any previously used Race results tags will need to be removed.



MSBDISTRIBUTORS



All riders <u>**MUST**</u> push their bike through the "Tag Check" prior to racing. Failure to correctly apply tags may result in no or missing race times. It is the riders responsibility to ensure tags are applied correctly and tested via the Tag Check prior to racing.

CATERING: Catering will be provided by:

TOILETS & SHOWERS: Toilets and limited Showers are available at the venue.

CAMPING: is available from Friday at the track. It is requested that a \$10.00 donation (family / carload) is made for camping at sign on.

CAMP FIRES: Fires are permitted provided they are in a suitable container e.g. brazier or tub. Please bring your own fire wood. Gas cookers are allowed.

RUBBISH: CBS Bins has kindly donated a large skip bin which riders can use to disposal of all rubbish. <u>Under no circumstances are tyres or flammable liquids such as oil, fuel to be placed in this bin</u>. The bin will be located adjacent to the toilets.

MOBILE COVERAGE: Is Ok

FIRSTCARE MEDICAL: has been organised for the event and will be in-attendance from 7.30 am on race day.

FUEL & NOISE TESTING: Fuel and noise testing may take place at random.

ENVIROMATS: Are Compulsory and must be used when re-fuelling, oiling chains etc. These are available at Sign On for \$10. each; penalties will apply as per the Supplementary Regulations for breach of this requirement.

GOGGLE TEAR OFFS: are not permitted to be used at this event as per of the 2024 MOMS General Competition Rules.

DOGS & FOOTWEAR: Please note: Animals (except human aid dogs) and Push Bikes are NOT permitted at the event. NO open footwear.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: Riders are required to have at least one: 2kg dry powder A:B (E) class charged and tagged fire extinguisher clearly visible and available to the rider/pit crew at all time in the re-fuel area.

OTHER NOTES:


- Please advise the Clerk of Course or Race Secretary if you are not continuing to compete at a round. All Injuries must be reported to the Clerk of Course.






DIRECTIONS to the event: 345 Snake Gully Road, Harrogate, SA
